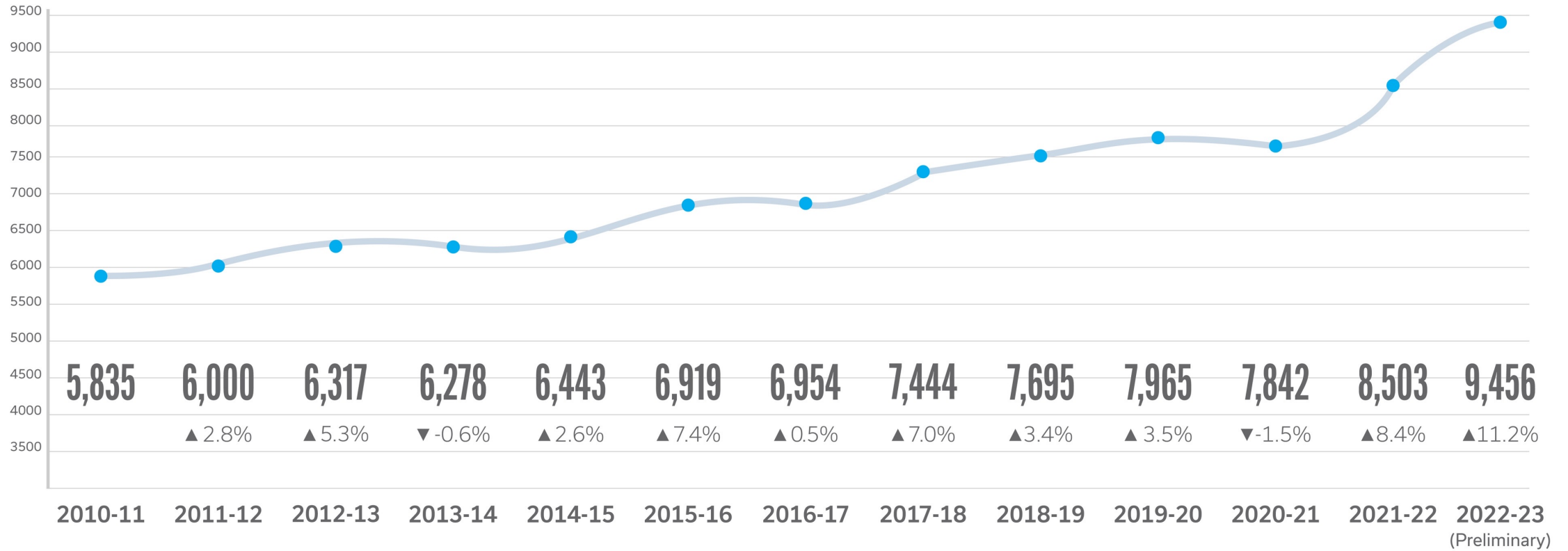

OVERALL DEGREES/CERTIFICATES CONFERRED



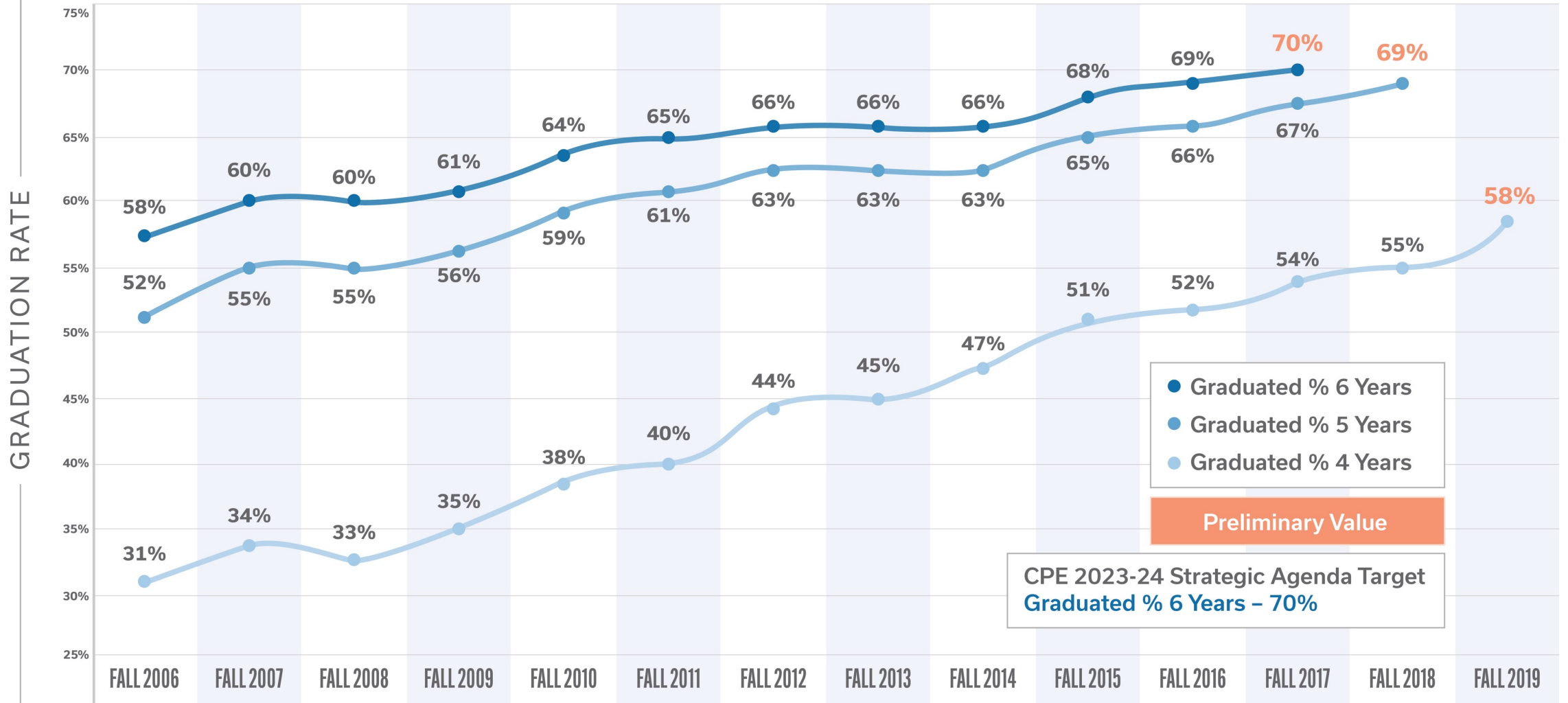

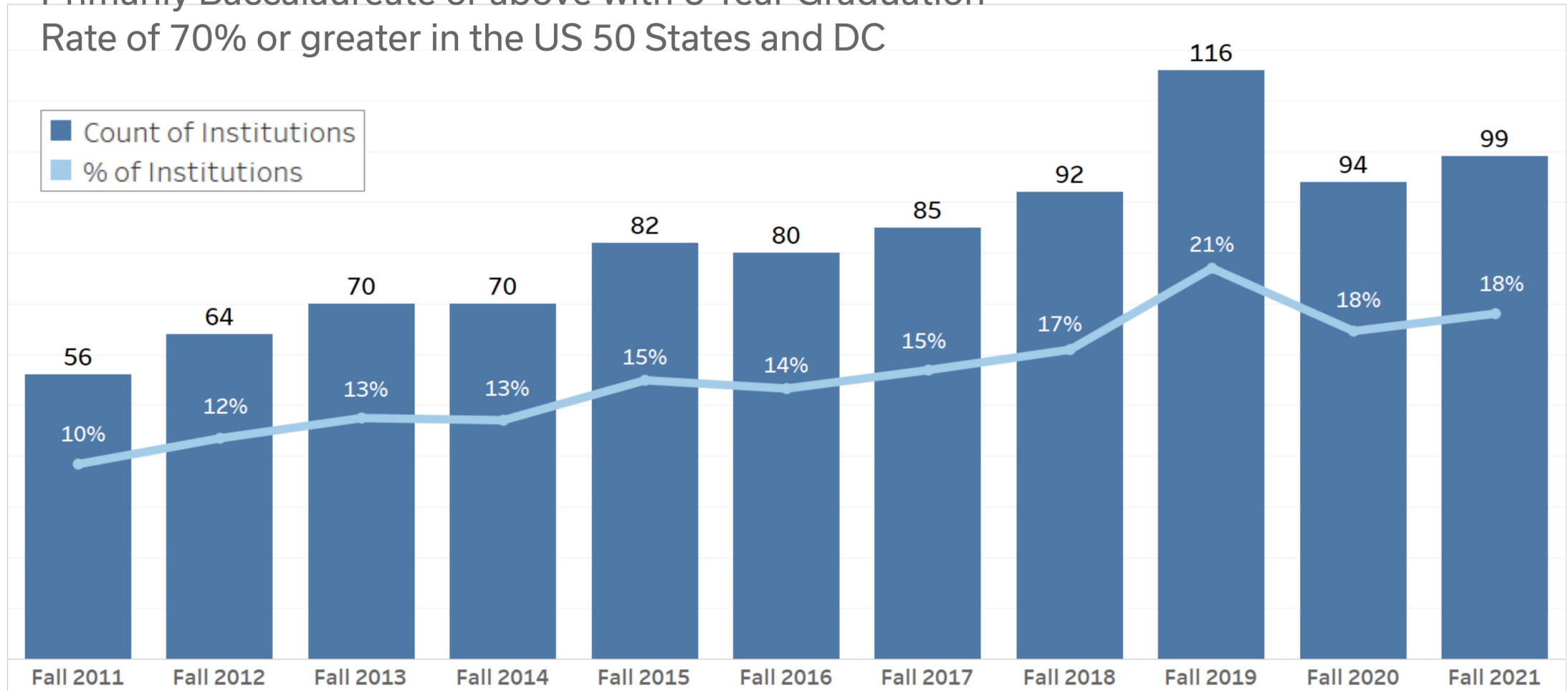
# GRADUATION RATES BY COHORT TERM



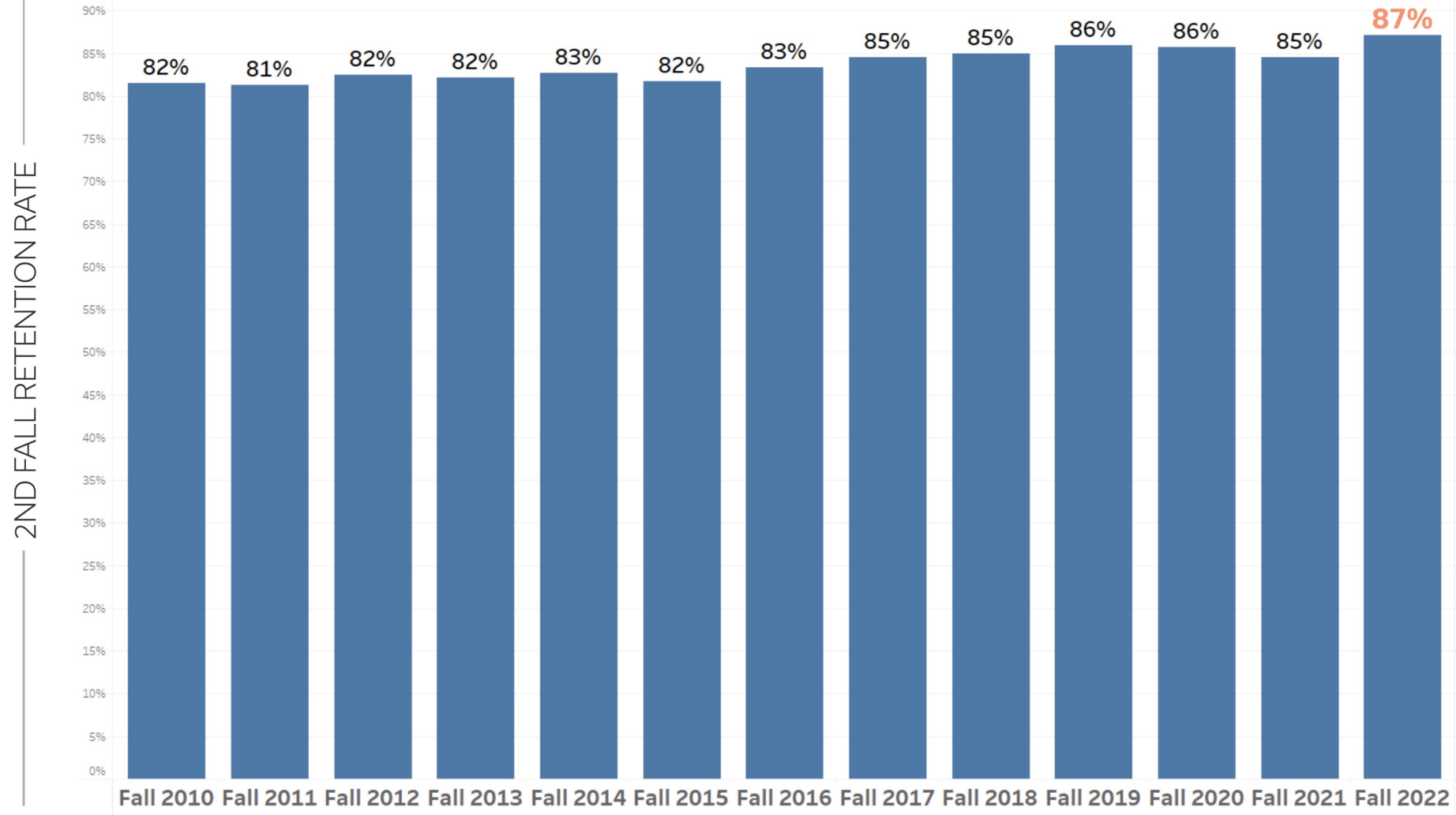


## PUBLIC INSTITUTIONS WITH A 6-YEAR GRADUATION RATE OF 70%+

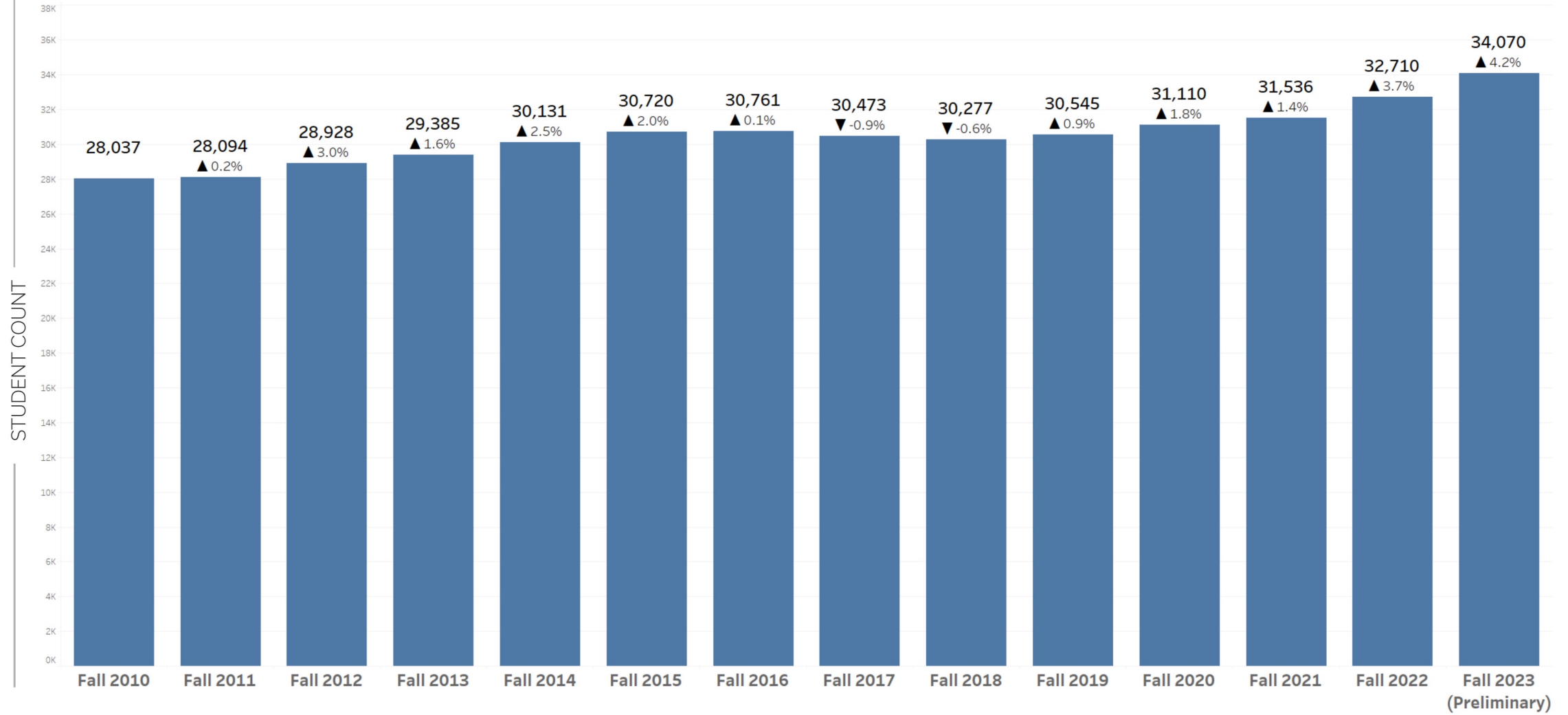

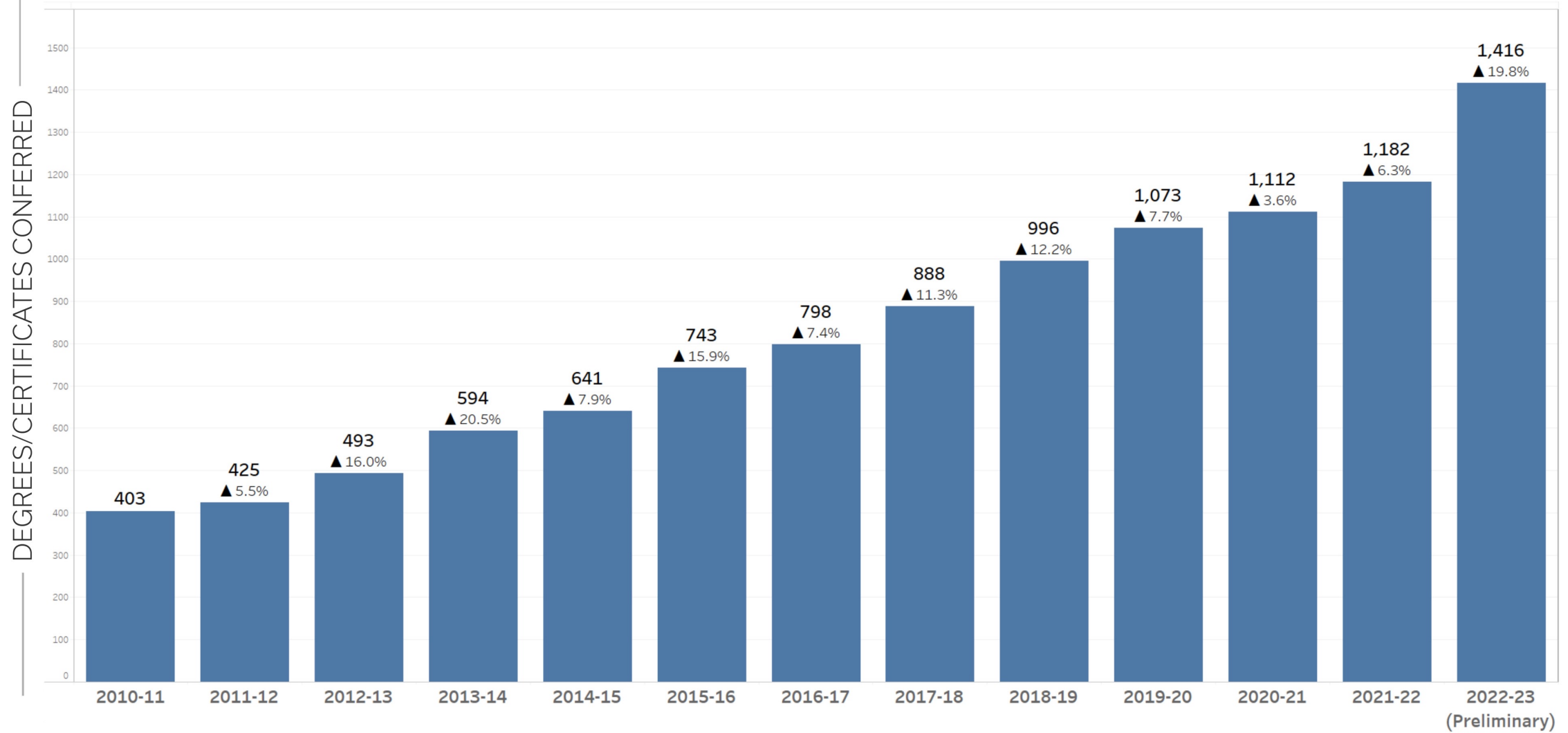

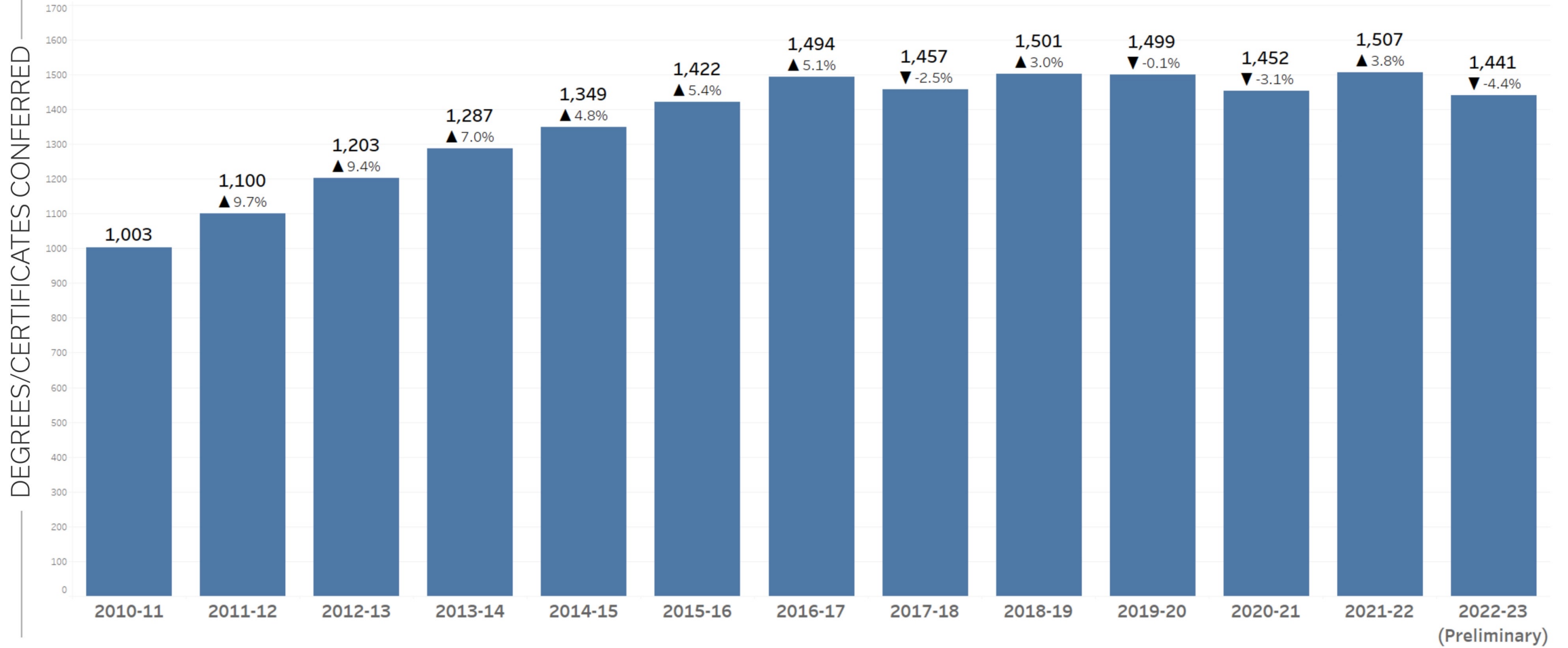

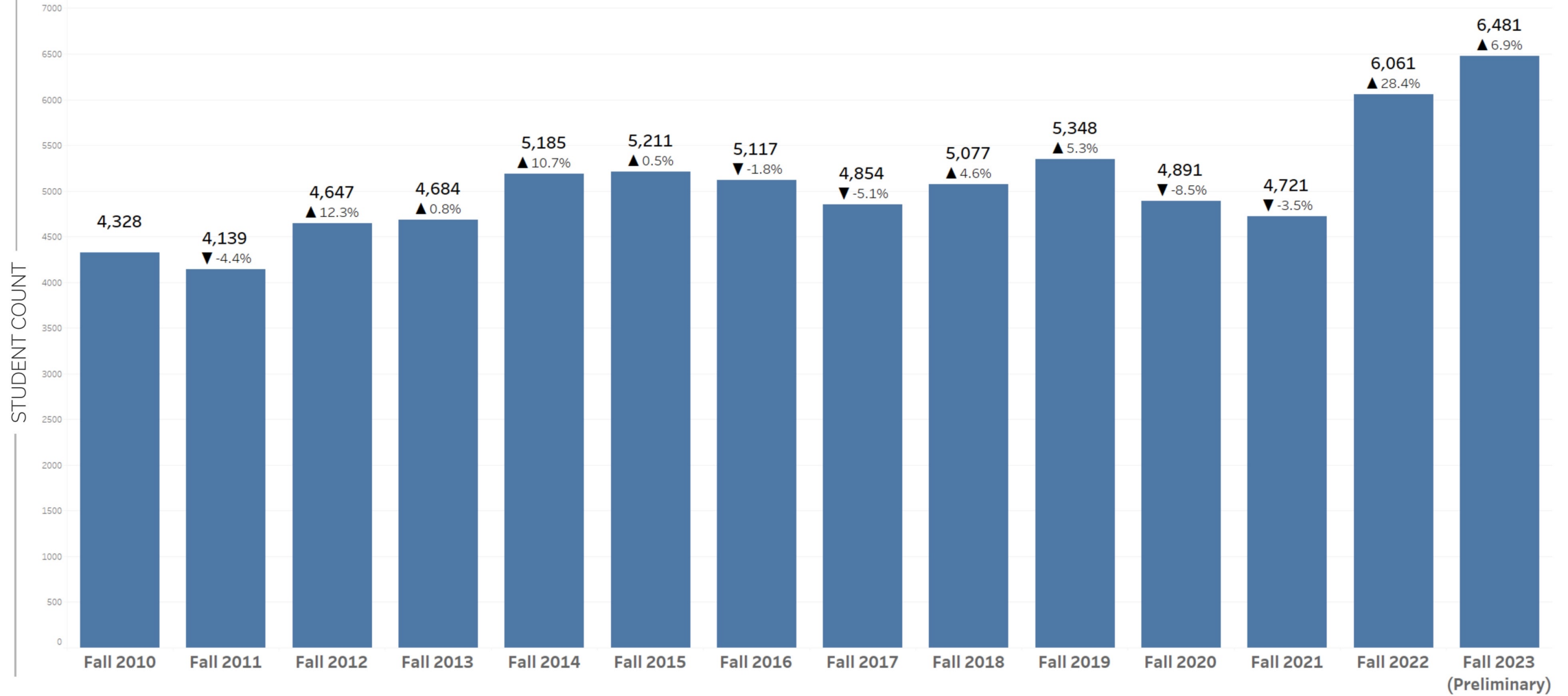

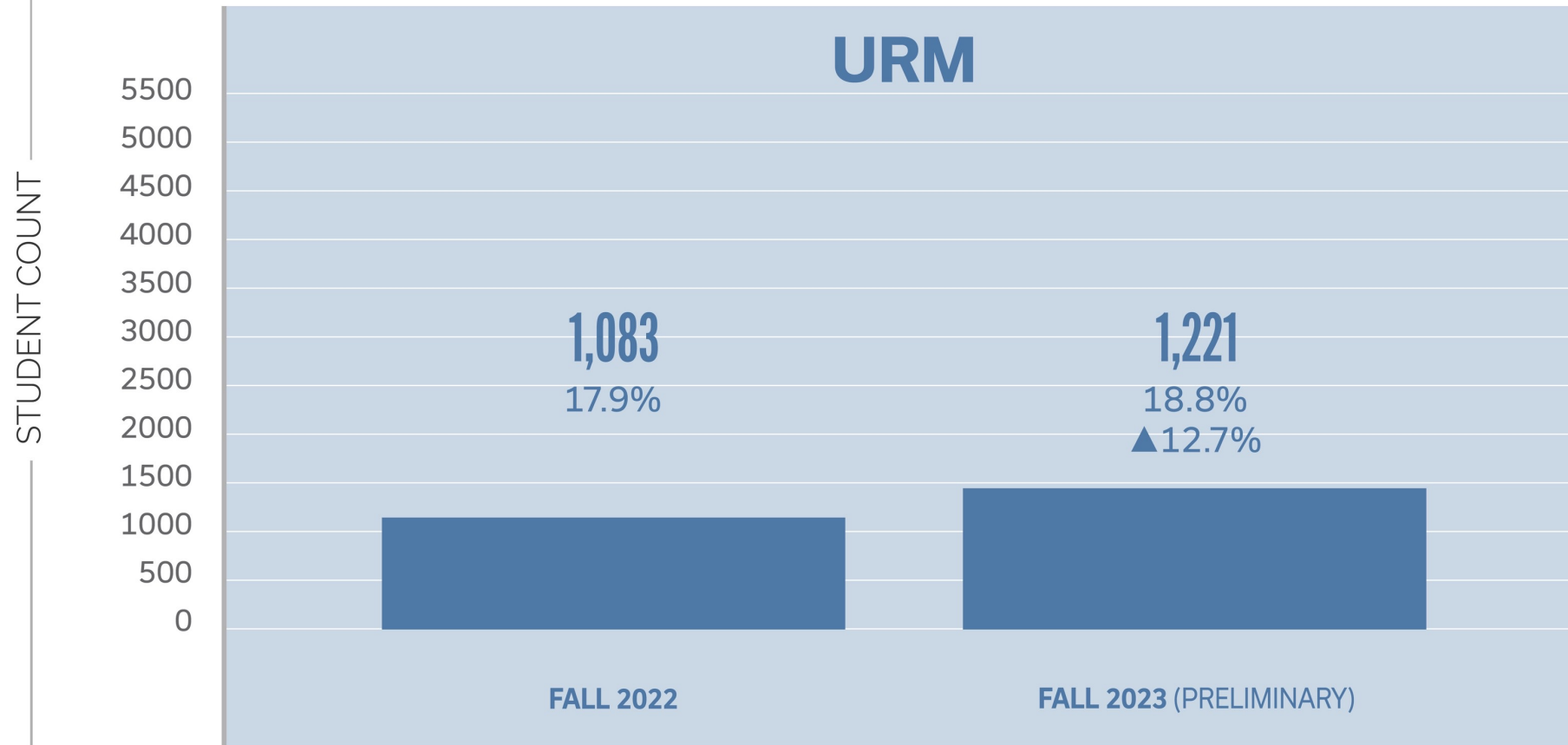

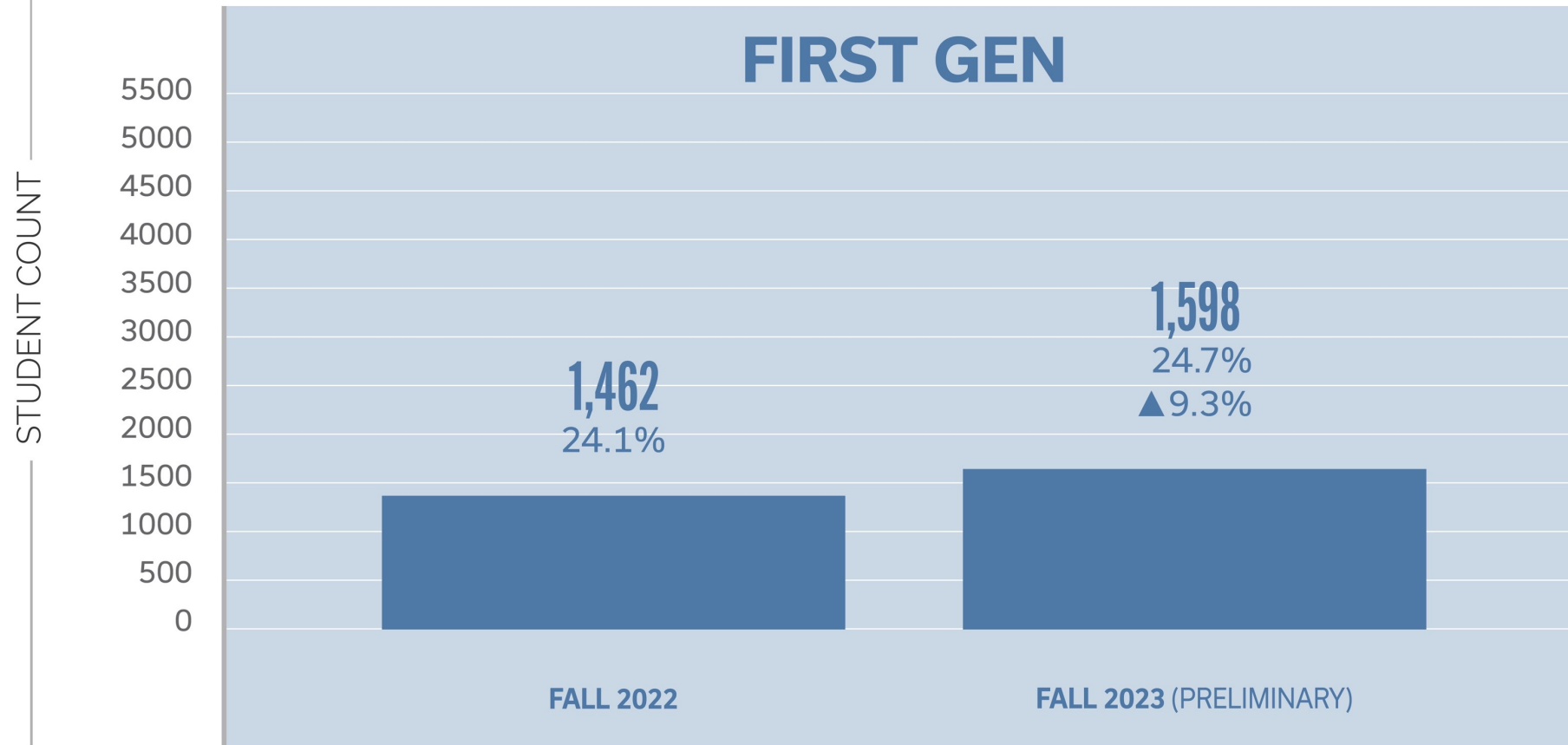
