On June 2, 2014, Dr. Lisa Cassis agreed to serve as Interim Vice President for Research until June 30, 2015.

Dr. Cassis has spent the last year providing outstanding leadership to the University of Kentucky's research enterprise; was co-lead (along with Dr. Rodney Andrews) of the workgroup developing the "Research and Scholarly Work" portion of the University's next Strategic Plan; worked closely with me and our Government Relations team to successfully secure \$132.5 million in state support for our new research building; facilitated campus-wide conversations with deans, researchers, and other constituencies on how best to grow — in a strategic, efficient, and effective way — our research portfolio; and overseen the day-to-day operations of the Office of Research. I am very grateful for her service.

I have spent the last two months in conversation with over 50 people across our campus about the current condition and future direction of our research enterprise. The feedback has been valuable as I consider the next steps for the Office.
